William J. Antholis serves as Director and CEO of the Miller Center, a nonpartisan affiliate of the University of Virginia that specializes in presidential scholarship, public policy, and political history. The Miller Center's First Year: POTUS 2017 project published over 60 essays across eleven substantive topics, hosted 25 public events across the United States, launched a new website, and engaged policy-makers and the press.

Dr. Antholis served as managing director at The Brookings Institution from 2004 to 2014. At Brookings, Antholis authored Inside Out India and China: Local Politics Go Global. Along with Strobe Talbott, he also authored of Fast Forward: Ethics and Politics in the Age of Global Warming. He has published articles, book chapters, and opinion pieces on U.S. politics, U.S. foreign policy, international organizations, the G8, climate change, and trade.

From 1995 to 1999, Antholis served in the U.S. government at the White House's National Security Council and National Economic Council, at the State Department's policy planning staff and also in the economic affairs bureau. Prior to joining Brookings, he served for five years as director of studies and senior fellow at the German Marshall Fund, a U.S. grant-making and public policy institution devoted to strengthening transatlantic cooperation. He was also an international affairs fellow of the Council on Foreign Relations and a visiting fellow at the Center of International Studies at Princeton University.

Antholis earned his Ph.D. from Yale University in politics (1993) and his B.A. from the University of Virginia in government and foreign affairs (1986).
