

- Learning takes TIME and EFFORT.




POSITIVE ATTITUDE and to NOT GIVE UP when things get hard

### POSITIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT The POWER of MISTAKES


An integral part of the learning process.





Examples of famous people who experienced massive failure at one point in their lives.








### POSITIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT The POWER of MISTAKES

## HOMEWORK

- \* Explain to the students the IMPORTANCE of homework:
  - ✓ Means to achieving their GOAL to LEARN
  - **✓** PRACTICE
  - ✓ Improves UNDERSTANDING
  - ✓ Helps to RETAIN understanding



## HOMEWORK \* I do NOT grade homework assignments

- I only give CONSTRUCTIVE FEEDBACK
- Remember to PRAISE THE EFFORT



## HOMEWORK \*\*TIMELY feedback

- Turn in daily assignments ELECTRONICALLY
  - > I take a look at most of students' work BEFORE going over it in class
- Do not only ask students who solved an exercise correctly to present the solution in class, but also students who had difficulty with that exercise.

#### RESULTS

- Students more interested in LEARNING
- More students turning in their OWN WORK
- Students more willing to participate even if they didn't know the answer
- More students were not afraid of making mistakes or asking questions

### DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED

- Not all students submitted the homework assignments
- Assessing daily assignments is quite timeconsuming
