

VISITING ACADEMIC POSITION

The Department of English Studies at the University of Cyprus invites applications for one (1) visiting academic position at the rank of Lecturer in Translation Studies, preferably in the area of **Specialized Translation** (LSP-Translation) for the Spring Semester 2022, with a possibility of renewal for another semester (Fall Semester 2022), pending final approval and funding by the University authorities.

TEACHING REQUIREMENTS

The successful candidate will be required to teach the following courses:

Spring Semester 2022:

ENG 280 Translation Theory

ENG 5XX Elective in Translation Studies ENG 5XX Elective in Translation Studies

The successful candidate will be required to teach and guide students, and to administer and mark the final exam for the courses s/he will teach. Teaching duties begin on 17 January 2022, ending on 31 May 2022.

The monthly gross salary for the position of Visiting Lecturer is approximately €2,723.17. This amount can be subject to changes imposed by the Government.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants should hold a PhD on a subject relevant to the area of the position and have excellent command of both English and Greek.

Applicants need not be citizens of the Republic of Cyprus. Applicants should however ensure, before applying, that in case they are selected they will be residing in Cyprus on a full-time basis during the employment period; submission of application implies acceptance of this condition. Acceptance of this term must be also explicitly stated in the letter of application.

APPLICATION

Applicants must submit the following:

- Letter of application, with a) indicative titles/short descriptions for the elective courses, and b) the names of two academics who will submit letters of recommendation.
- Full Curriculum Vitae
- Copies of degrees and transcripts. The successful candidate will be asked to submit certified copies from the Ministry of Education of Cyprus (if degrees were acquired in Cyprus) or from the respective institution abroad.
- If applying for the first time to the Department, applicants must also arrange for two academic referees to send letters of recommendation directly to it (see below).



A sample of a course curriculum may be requested at a later stage.

In case an applicant is employed in the public or wider public sector of the Republic of Cyprus, she/he must obtain permission to work at the University from the appropriate Department/Ministry, or wider public sector authority.

The applicant who will be selected will work entirely at the University of Cyprus. If the applicant works anywhere else, an unpaid leave or a Sabbatical leave should be ensured.

Applications and references may only be submitted **electronically** (and exclusively as pdf documents) to the Translation Studies Coordinator, Assoc. Prof. George Floros (gfloros@ucy.ac.cy).

The deadline for receiving applications is 19 November 2021, at 12 pm noon (Cyprus time).
