Address by the President of the Republic Mr N. Anastasiades at the opening ceremony of the Confucius Institute, Univ. of Cyprus

The cooperation between the University of Cyprus and the Beijing Institute of Education via the Confucius Institute at the University of Cyprus will lead to innovative and progressive collaborations in the academic, research and educational fields, which will pave the way for the "blossoming" of the already dynamic relationship between our two peoples.
